1. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

- gender;

2. USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

The table below describes the main purposes for which we process your personal information, the categories of your information involved and our lawful basis for being able to do this.

To conduct data analysis to better understand participation and trends within the sport for our clients	Contact details and Summary and record of our consultation and/or information supplied by our clients. This is not normally specific to individuals.
To arrange and manage any contracts for the provision of any services or products	Contact details, transaction and payment information. Records of your interactions with us usually on email system.

3. DIRECT MARKETING

4. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We share personal information with the following parties:

- Any party approved by you.

- the right to request the correction of inaccurate personal information we hold about you;
- the right to request the erasure of your personal information in certain limited circumstances;
- the right to restrict processing of your personal information where certain requirements are met;
- the right to object to the processing of your personal information;
- the right to request that we transfer elements of your data either to you or another service provider; and
- the right to object to certain automated decision-making processes using your personal information.
